Stuttgart High School News Team Wins Prestigious National Award

On Wednesday, May 14th, the Stuttgart High School student newspaper, The Stuttgart Insider, won third prize in the Best Publication category of the National English Honor Society-Harvard Crimson Student Journalism Award. The award, which recognizes quality of both writing and presentation in student-led publications at schools with active NEHS chapters, comes with a prize of \$275.

The editorial team of The Stuttgart Insider, consisting of NEHS members Emily W, Tadek N, and Gabby F, submitted a PDF of an issue of the paper published during the school year to be considered. The issue can be found here.

The student newspaper has been incredibly active, publishing 12 issues covering topics related to school events, politics, student opinion, pop culture, and more since September. Since the paper was started last school year, it has come a long way towards its goal to produce articles by and for Stuttgart High School students.
